ISF WSC EDUCATIONAL GAMES

The Executive Committee (EC) of the International School Sport Federation (ISF) has decided to entrust its aegis to the organisation of the 6th ISF World Educational Games. The 6th ISF World Educational Games are organised by the ISF, the Panhellenic Union of the Graduates of Physical Education - PEPFA, Central Union of Municipalities of Greece (KEDE), International Olympic Academy (IOA), Municipalities of ATHENS, ANCIENT OLYMPIA, NEA SMYRNI and ILIOUPOLIS, the Region of WESTERN GREECE and the Culture, Sport and Youth Organisation of Athens (OPANDA) according to the International School Sport Federation rules.

Invitations to participate in these ISF World Educational Games are being sent to all school sport entities which are full or associate members of the ISF, to the members of the ISF Executive Committee for information and to Special Olympics International and Special Olympics EurAsia, implementing the MoU signed by both organisations.

We have pleasure in sending you Bulletin 2 of the 6th ISF World Educational Games which will take place from **27 March to 2 April 2019** in the Region of Attica and the City of Ancient Olympia in Greece. This bulletin contains further information to that published in bulletin 1.

Registration is still open for countries that did not register yet. If your country intends to participate **you must register through ERAS by 3 March at the latest** (phase 1 and 2).

2. Risk Assessment

The LOC informs that the accommodation sites are high quality hotels. The whole event is co-organised with high level public authorities. Police authorities will be notified of the detailed event program and all necessary co-operation will occur. All these facts facilitate the security of the event. There is, in general, no special risk and the security assessment is very positive, due to the strong safety in Olympia and Athens. Buses will be allocated for all the event activities from and to the hotels.

3. Visa Policy

VISA requirements and documents to entreat various Ports of entry (train, bus, airport) have to be checked by the individual nations. If you encounter any trouble during your journey, you can contact the LOC.

PARTICIPATION

The delegations from the following ISF Members participating in this event will be: Brazil, Bulgaria, Bangladesh, China P.R., England, France, Italy, Russia, Ukraine, Special Olympics Great Britain, Special Olympics Italy.

1. Condition for participation

Each country may enter one or more delegations. Students may be from the same school or from different schools. As the event focuses on education and culture, students can be selected from any kind of sport, but they should have special merits in school sport in the country concerned.



Each country may additionally enter one or more delegations composed of pupils with intellectual disability (Special Olympics Teams)

Neither older nor younger student will be accepted, unless for the Special Olympics Teams where exceptions can be requested.

Teachers: every delegation must be accompanied by one teacher.

Head of Delegation: he/she may not combine the function of Head of Delegation and coach or another official function. He/she shall be the sole intermediary between his/her delegation and the Local Organising Committee and the ISF Delegate.

Additional adults: function must be specified: Deputy HoD, doctor, physiotherapist, interpreter, security personnel, ministry representative, journalist...

Any other additional person will not be considered part of the official delegation and will not be accredited by the LOC.

All students must be attending schools which provide a general education.

The following are not eligible to participate:

- pupils of vocational schools who only attend that school as a complement to their vocational training;
- school teams and pupils enrolled at schools which provide sports training without any general education;
- part-time (e.g. afternoon) sports schools which take pupils from a variety of schools for training in one or more sports;
- teams formed as part of clubs, companies, universities or other institutions.

Implementing the MoU signed by the ISF and Special Olympics International, delegations from Special Olympics Teams, from all over the world can also participate in the 6th ISF World School Sport Educational Games.

All disciplines will be unified (participation of athletes of ISF delegations together with athletes of Special Olympics).

All the delegations will be hosted in hotels in the areas of Attica and Ancient Olympia. Details regarding the accommodation will be released in due time.

ADMINISTRATION & FINANCE

1. Registration

The final deadline for registration Phase 2 is **3.03.2019**. After this date the organiser of the event may reject any new entries.

Erasmus Registration Phase 3 reminder and deadline is at the latest **7.03.2019**.

Phase 3 requires the following information:

- Travel
 - a. Schedule
 - b. Date
 - c. Number of flights (if more than one)
 - d. Number of people per flight (if more than one)
- School
 - a. Name and address of the school for each team
 - b. City
- For each accredited person
 - a. First and last name
 - b. Date of birth
 - c. ID photo

 - e. Diet or food restriction
 - f. Jersey number and colour
- Additionally, the Head of delegation shall provide
 - a. His/her mobile phone number

2. Fees

a) Participation fee

In accordance with the rules laid down by ISF, the minimum payment to be made to the organisers of the event amounts to 50 € per person and per night. The participation fee (per person/per night) in EURO for all participants is as follows:

The fee covers full board accommodation for the duration of the event. It covers the competition, cultural programme activities and all transport in connection with the official programme (arrival, departure, sports and cultural programmes).

On Registration phase 3, each delegation should provide a detailed list regarding the adults room preference (i.e. single or double bed room) according to the “payment overview”.



b) ISF levy

An additional ISF levy of 40 € per member in the delegation must be paid together with the balance of the participation fee.

c) Donation to the School Sport Foundation

The ISF School Sport Foundation intends to provide underprivileged school children with opportunities to access sports training by highly qualified PE teachers and trainers and to dispose of good quality school sport equipment and infrastructure. One of the occasions to help the Foundation is the Charity Gala Dinner in which the Heads of Delegation will be invited. An extra contribution of 50 € for taking part is requested.

A second way to raise funds for the School Sport Foundation is a free contribution that you can add to the 40 € ISF levy of the participants. You can add 5 €, 10 € or 15 € per participant to the ISF levy to pay. Instead of paying 40 €, you thus pay 45 €, 50 € or 55 € per participant.

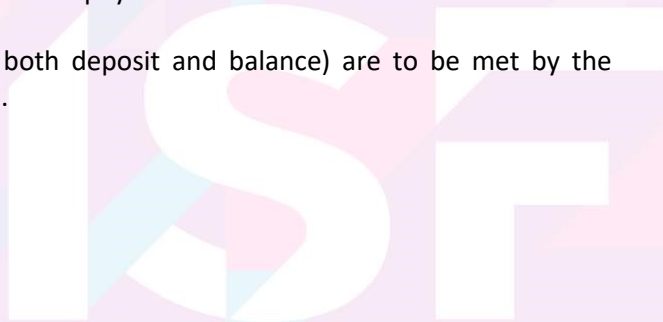

The balance is to be paid on arrival or in advance by bank transfer.

*Info about deposit. If deposit has been paid, then the deposit must be deducted from the total final payment.

All bank charges (for both deposit and balance) are to be met by the participating countries.



4. Insurance

Each country is required to provide insurance for each member of its delegation. At a minimum the insurance is to cover civil liability, material damage and medical costs.

6. Accreditation Procedure

All delegations will be welcomed, and transportation will be provided upon their arrival at Athens International Airport "ELEFTHERIOS VENIZELOS" (<https://www.aia.gr>)

Accreditation will take place all day on 27.03.2019. in AMALIA OLYMPIA HOTEL on the arrival day of delegations.

Head of Delegations are responsible for undergoing accreditation for their delegation.

The Control Commission and representatives of the Local Organizing Committee will proceed to check the following documents:

1. Finances: proof of payment of the balance including any bank charges and if not sent to the LOC before, the payment overview. To help the Local Organizing Committee to process your payment correctly please complete the form 'payment overview' in attachment and send it to the LOC by e-mail when you pay the balance.
2. Accreditation

For the delegation:

- a) the official form signed by the Headmaster of the school and the legal School Sport Entity, confirming that all players are full time students at the school, since the beginning of the school year.
- b) the document certifying that the delegation is covered by an insurance that at least covers civil liability, material damage and medical costs.

For every student:

- a) the passport (or identity card) bearing family name, first name, photograph, nationality and date of birth
- b) the use of image consent form

When checking is finished the Head of delegation will receive the accreditation cards for each participant in his/her delegation. Participants



must carry the accreditation card with them all the time to have access to transport, competition, activities and meals.

LOGISTICS

1. Arrival & Departure

Delegations will be welcomed at the terminal of the Athens International Airport “ELEFTHERIOS VENIZELOS” (<https://www.aia.gr>)

With the following signs of the event:

All transportation from arrival till departure will be provided by the LOC. Transportation will be provided by means of bus.

Delegations are to arrive on 27 March 2019.

Delegations are to depart on 02 April 2019.

Extended stay:

Extended stay possibilities may occur in the following scenario:

- When the distance between Athens and the capital of a participating country on another continent exceeds 5000 kilometres the delegation may extend its stay by arriving one day earlier or leaving one day later at the ISF daily fee.

Otherwise

- The organisation of an extended stay for the delegation (before or after the event) is a matter for the country concerned, it shall not be the responsibility of the L.O.C.

NON-SPORT ACTIVITIES

- Opening Ceremony:

The opening ceremony will take place at the **Olympia City Hall Open Theater** on 29/03. The ceremony will be Outdoors. There is an alternative Indoor Venue available in case of bad weather. The Opening Ceremony is open to public.

- "International Get-together"

Delegations are required to take part in an "International Get-together" organised with the aim of encouraging exchanges between the different cultures of participating countries.

The young people are invited to introduce and to promote their countries and their culture in an original way. This will take place during the *International Get-together* session on 31 March, at 19.30 hrs. Each delegation is to organise a stand at the "Tourist Fair" on the theme 'Suppose you came to spend your holidays in my country'. This presentation may be made in the form of leaflets, video, CD, photos or other original ideas, for example by offering a taste of typical culinary specialties (dishes, drinks, ...). In addition, each delegation may, if it wishes, introduce a facet of its country's culture on stage (the stage is yours – dance, songs, sketches ...) maximum 5 minutes.

For workshops 2 & 3 no preparation is needed. All workshops will be followed by relevant Unified Sport Action (Sport Events).

- Closing Ceremony:

The closing ceremony will take place at Nea Smyrni area on the evening of 1 April, prior to the “Gala Party”.

In total, FOUR (4) Educational Sessions, FIVE (5) Educational Unified Sport Activities and TWO (2) Guided Tours will take place during the event. All the Educational Sessions and Sport Activities will be conducted by distinguished scientists, IOA experts in Olympic Education and international level coaches.

2. Certificate

Each participant will receive a commemorative certificate.

As it is an “Education through Sport” event, no medals will be presented.

MEDICAL

1. Food & Beverage

Food will be supplied by the hotels and will be served at the hotel dining halls.

Accredited persons will receive 3 meals per day:

- Breakfast
- Lunch
- Dinner

Alternatively, if necessary, following the program, it can be in a restaurant at a location, or a lunch box can be provided.

Arrival day: lunch and/or dinner (according to arrival time)

Other days: breakfast (hotel), lunch – dinner (hotel or restaurant or lunch box)

Departure day: breakfast – lunch or packed meal (according to departure time)

There will be free access to drinking water to all accredited individuals at accommodation, workshops, sport activities, etc.



The LOC will accommodate to specific diet and food restrictions, which will be specified following Phase 3 registration for participants.

2. Hospitals

Public hospitals and/or Health Centres are located within a range of 3 to 5 km from accommodation.

Medical care will be assured to all accredited persons by a certified doctor following the event on a 24/7 basis and being available throughout the duration of the event.

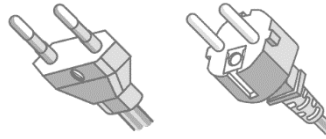
