

TRAVEL ARRANGEMENTS FROM HONG KONG

If you are traveling to Hong Kong airport, please find important information regarding the chartered service offered by Hong Kong & Macao International Airport Transportation Service Co. Limited.

Hong Kong & Macao International Airport Transportation Service Co. Limited is a licensed transportation company under the Airport Authority Hong Kong (AAHK). They specialize in providing transportation services for passengers and baggage between the Hong Kong International Airport (HKIA) and the Hong Kong-Zhuhai-Macao Bridge (HZMB) Macau Port. For the chartered service, the company charges a rate equivalent to a fully occupied bus, which amounts to HKD \$10,080 per one-way trip from HKIA to HZMB Macau Port and vice versa. This calculation is based on a price of HK \$280 per ticket for a 36-seater bus. To ensure a smooth and efficient service, the company kindly requests that clients provide their travel details at least 7 days in advance. This will allow them sufficient time to organize the necessary resources and deliver the highest quality service possible.

GOOD TO KNOW

ABOUT THE ACCOMMODATION

The room facilities include basic furniture and mattresses. Residents should bring various items by themselves, including a cup/portable bottle, toiletries (e.g. toothbrush, toothpaste, razor, comb), personal medicine, clothes, umbrella, slippers, dryer and charger. The LOC will arrange shampoo and shower gel. For the towel, we will arrange some one-time disposal towels but we encourage the teams to use their own towel due to environmental protection.

The residential College facilities include pantries and garbage rooms on each floor, with a drinking fountain for water supply. Residents should bring their own cup or portable bottles. Laundry, drying machines, and dryers are located on each floor. First aid boxes are also placed in the pantries for emergency use. Residents should use the equipment carefully. A damage fee will be levied if any item in the room is found damaged.

Residents must present their identification or room key card to enter the college, and they are responsible for keeping their room key card secure without transferring it to others. If a key card is lost, a replacement fee will be charged. Residents are not allowed to enter rooms of the opposite gender or change rooms without prior approval. Residents should respect the privacy and quiet environment needed by others, especially during the designated **quiet hours from 10pm to 9am.**

Two banks in the University of Macau provide foreign currency exchange services, which are open in office hours. Therefore, we would recommend the teams to exchange some Macao Patacas once arrive. Also, Hong Kong Dollars is acceptable for most of the shops and restaurants in Macao, China so you can prepare some Hong Kong Dollars before your arrival. There are some ATMs located near the Dormitory and competition venues. They accept Visa and Master mainly.

OVERVIEW

Founded in 1981, the University of Macau (UM) is an international public comprehensive university in Macao, with a multicultural campus and a system of whole-person education underpinned by faculties and residential colleges in an international education setup. 80 per cent of its faculty members are from outside Macao. With English as the main medium of instruction, the university is committed to producing creative and socially responsible graduates with a global mindset and international competitiveness.

A UNIQUE RESIDENTIAL COLLEGE SYSTEM

UM's residential college (RC) system provides a platform for knowledge integration based on the university's '4-in-1' model of whole-person education. This is unique among universities in Macao. There are currently ten RCs at UM, namely Chao Kuang Piu College, Cheng Yu Tung College, Cheong Kun Lun College, Choi Kai Yau College, Henry Fok Pearl Jubilee College, Lui Che Woo College, Ma Man Kei and Lo Pak Sam College, Moon Chun Memorial College, Shiu Pong College, and Stanley Ho East Asia College.

As a complement to the university's faculty-based system, the RCs serve as a vehicle for whole-person education through systematic planning of experiential programmes, with the aim of nurturing students who are successful in their studies and whole-person development. The RCs strive to enhance students' seven competencies: responsible citizenship, global competitiveness, knowledge integration, teamwork and collaboration, service and leadership, cultural engagement, and healthy lifestyle.




About University of Macau

INTERNATIONAL REPUTATION

UM is ranked No. 193 in the Times Higher Education (THE) World University Rankings, No. 14 in the THE Young University Rankings, No. 36 in the THE Asia University Rankings, and No. 1 in the Association of Portuguese Speaking Universities. In the Quacquarelli Symonds (QS) World University Rankings, it is ranked No. 245. In the Essential Science Indicators (ESI) rankings, it is among the top 1 percent in 12 subjects, namely Engineering, Materials Science, Computer Science, Chemistry, Pharmacology & Toxicology, Clinical Medicine, Psychiatry/Psychology, Biology & Biochemistry, Social Sciences, General, Agricultural Sciences, Economics & Business, Environment/Ecology.

ISF ACADEMY





The ISF Academy is the educational center of the International School Sport Federation delivering online and onsite capacity-building activities for teachers, school sports representatives, coaches, officials, and students around the world. It aims to recognize and or to upgrade the knowledge and skills of any of these stakeholders involved or planning to be involved in national, continental, or international sports, educational networks, institutions, events, or organisation.

The mission of this body is to design and deliver short-, mid-, and long-term quality education and capacity-building activities for students, physical education teachers, national school sport representatives, coaches and officials around the world. These educational programmes will be held online on the ISF Academy platform prior to the events and particularly during the organisation of ISF events on-site, after the competition hours.

Therefore, before and during this international ISF event, heads of delegation, coaches, referees, international school athletes, and local school students will have the opportunity to take part in various interactive educational activities on different topics.







SAFEGUARDING CHILDREN IN SPORT & ANTIDOPING WORKSHOPS

As well as various webinars taking place several days before the event to support the Head of Delegation and Coaches in preparing their mission within an ISF event (these online educational & capacity building activities are compulsory to attend for all the following adult stakeholders taking part in ISF events), the ISF's promotion of school sport by the ISF Academy through its international events also involves the transmission of knowledge through workshops on two themes that are dear to us all: **Safeguarding Children in Sport** and **Doping Prevention in Sport**. ISF firmly believes that children have and must have the necessary inner resources, through these workshops, to understand, identify, and react to negative behavior such as racism, gender inequality, or violence and abuse. The challenge for ISF is to find the right way to express difficult ideas and present complicated topics to young people so that they understand, but also so that they correctly apprehend this problem and are able to react to it.

Raising awareness and enabling participants to transfer their knowledge to their peers back home are also key elements of ISF. During this event, athletes from all over the world will attend several workshop sessions given by experts in the field, passing on their knowledge and experience through dedicated, constructive, and interactive pedagogy.

Safeguarding and Anti-doping seminars will be organised on **25th**, **26th and 27th of June** in the afternoon or evening hours.







HEADS OF DELEGATION AND COACHES PROGRAMME

The ISF Academy will organise an online webinar, a few weeks before the event to support the Head of Delegation, Coaches in preparing their mission within an ISF event. These online educational & capacity building activities are compulsory to attend for all the following adults' stakeholders taking part in ISF events:

Heads of Delegation (Compulsory) Coaches (Compulsory)

The programme will be composed of different modules related to the ISF, the Organising Committee, and several crucial subjects related to Safeguarding Children in Sport, Anti-Doping, and Diplomacy in Sport. Other topics might be added as well.



Any adults having key responsibilities towards, the ISF, the Local Organising Committee, and ultimately school students within an ISF international event shall be taking part in this crucial educational programme which will contribute to supporting these adults in their duty and mission before, during, and after the event.

Important: The head of the delegation and the coaches will have to participate in the complete training programme to be authorized to receive accreditation for the event.

Note: The Head of Delegations and Coaches will be informed in due time of the dates of the online webinar. The detail programme of this webinar as well.

After each online workshop, participants will receive a link to complete assessments. To validate their certificate of completion, each participant must have a minimum of 50% success rate to all the assessments before receiving the certificate.

BALANCE FEE PAYMENT

Balance fee payment = Participation fee - Deposit (already paid)

The balance fee payment is to be paid before the start of the event (all bank charges are to be met by the participating delegation).

Participation fee

The participation fee covers full board accommodation for the duration of the event plus competition, cultural programme activities and all local transport from the arrival to the official port of entry to the departure of the team.

The participation fee is composed of:

- 1. Rates by night: minimum 60€/night/delegation member
- 2.ISF levy:
 - 100€ per person (ISF members)
 - 150€ per person (non-ISF members)

GOOD TO KNOW

MACAO TRAVEL ADAPTORS

You will need to consider what to pack, to ensure you can use your personal electrical appliances safely whilst abroad. This normally includes the use of a travel adaptor, which is a device that simply allows you to plug any electrical appliance into a foreign electrical socket. It is important to note that it does not convert the voltage or frequency.

For Macao the associated plug type is G, which is the plug that has three rectangular pins in a triangular pattern. Macao operates on a 220V supply voltage and 50Hz.



MACAO PATACA

The Macao Pataca (MOP) is the official currency of Macao. It is often presented with the symbol MOP\$, as in MOP\$100.

MEDICATION

In case of emergency, there are hospitals and emergency services available 24 hours a day. The medical personnel can speak English, which can help patients who don't speak the local language. There will also be first-aid service, ambulance, and qualified medical personnel in the competition locations.

However, it is important for participants to note that they should bring their own necessary medications with them. The LOC will not be able to provide personal medication or prescriptions.

For the outpatient service, participates can also go to the Medical Center of University of Macau at the Room GOO2 of UM Sports Complex, with opening hours: Monday to Saturday 09:00 – 13:00 & 14:00 – 18:00. It will charge MOP\$100 each time.

NO-ALCOHOL AND NO-SMOKING POLICY

Participants are not permitted to consume or possess alcoholic beverages, nor are they allowed to smoke cigarettes or use any other tobacco products in the accommodation of the University of Macau. These rules are in place to maintain a safe and responsible environment for all attendees.
