Arrival at Macau International Airport or at Hong Kong-Zhuhai-Macao Bridge

- Upon your delegation's arrival, a bus will be stationed outside the terminal.
- The service staff with each team will be there to guide you to the bus, which will be ready to transport your delegation to the designated hotel.

Transfer to the University of Macau

- The bus will provide a comfortable journey to the University of Macau where your delegation will be accommodated for the duration of the event.
- Upon arrival at the University, our staff will be on hand to assist with check-in and ensure your delegation settles in smoothly.

Accreditation Process for Delegations

- Accreditation procedures will be conducted on June 22nd and June 23rd in the Ma Man Kei and Lo Pak Sam College (W33) and Cheong Kun Lun College (W34) of the University of Macau.
- After accreditation, there will be a specific transportation service for the Head of Delegation who will be accommodated in Grandview Hotel Macau





ACTIVITIES

The ISF Academy is the educational center of the International School Sport Federation delivering online and onsite capacity-building activities for teachers, school sports representatives, coaches, officials, and students around the world. It aims to recognize and or to upgrade the knowledge and skills of any of these stakeholders involved or planning to be involved in regional, national, continental, or international sports, educational networks, institutions, events, or organisation.

The mission of this body is to design and deliver short-, mid-, and long-term quality education and capacity-building activities for physical education teachers, national and regional school sport representatives, coaches, officials, and students around the world. These educational programmes will be held online on the ISF Academy platform prior to the events and particularly during the organisation of ISF events on-site, after the competition hours.

Therefore, before and during this international ISF event, heads of delegation, coaches, referees, international school athletes, and local school students will have the opportunity to take part in various interactive educational activities on different topics

You will find below a schedule and non-exhaustive list of themes that will be proposed to young athletes during this event:

- Safeguarding children in sport
- Anti-Doping prevention in Sport

Please note that **these activities are compulsory** to attend during event particularly for the school athletes.

The educational activities will take place on the 25th, 26th, 27th of June.











SAFEGUARDING CHILDREN IN SPORT

We believe that children have the inner resources if educated, to fully understand, identify and react in front of negative behavior such as racism, gender inequity or violence and abuse. The challenge for ISF is to find the right way to express difficult ideas and present complicated topics to young people in order for them, not only to understand but also to appropriately apprehend this issue and be able to react if facing it.

Creating awareness and giving the opportunity for the participants to able to transfer their knowledge when getting back home to their peers is also key to ISF.

Using storytelling, technical basic information, and fostering discussion, the Safeguarding workshop aims to give a clear understanding of the issues surrounding safeguarding in sport. It also aims to give youngsters the knowledge to identify and name abusive behaviours and understand how to react in such cases.

And finally, this class aims to give young people the tools to understand that it's not their fault, that they can ask for help, and where to find help.

Anti-doping education goes beyond the realm of sports. It serves as a platform to impart valuable life lessons and cultivate ethical values in young individuals. By emphasizing the importance of honesty, integrity, and personal responsibility, anti-doping education contributes to the moral development of young athletes. It encourages them to make informed choices, stand up against cheating, and develop a strong sense of integrity that extends beyond the realm of sports and into other aspects of their lives. anti-doping education plays a crucial role in shaping the attitudes and behaviors of young people involved in sports. Educating them about the risks, consequences, and ethical implications of doping, promotes health, fair play, and integrity while providing them with the necessary tools to make informed decisions that align with their long-term well-being and athletic aspirations.

The law and the rules are important, but it is not just rules that safeguard our sport for clean athletes, but also the measures and processes that help put those rules into action. We must all play our part in promoting fair play and that means gaining an appreciation of what leads to certain decisions being made.

DELEGATION SERVICE

About the Accommodation

The room facilities include basic furniture, mattresses, pillows, bed covers, and blankets. Residents **should bring** various items by themselves, including a cup/portable bottle, toiletries (e.g. toothbrush, toothpaste, razor, comb), personal medicine, clothes, umbrella, slippers, dryer, and charger. The LOC will arrange shampoo and shower gel. For the towel, we will arrange some one-time disposal towels but we **encourage the teams to use** their own towel due to environmental protection.

The residential College facilities include pantries and garbage rooms on each floor, with a drinking fountain for water supply. Residents should **bring their own cups or portable bottles.** Laundry, drying machines, and dryers are located on each floor. First aid boxes are also placed in the pantries for emergency use. **Residents should use the equipment carefully. A damage fee will be levied if any item in the room is found damaged.** Residents must present their identification or room key card to enter the college, and they are responsible for keeping their room key card secure without transferring it to others. If a key card is lost, a replacement fee will be charged. **Residents are not allowed to enter rooms of the opposite gender or change rooms without prior approval.** Residents should respect the privacy and quiet environment needed by others, especially during the **designated quiet hours from 10 pm to 9 am.**

Room cleaning is available upon request. A cleaner's timetable will be displayed at the information desk. If you would like to request a cleaning, please put your name and room number on the available session. First come, first served. Please ensure that at least one resident is present in the room while the cleaner is cleaning, as the cleaner will not be able to enter the room otherwise.

Two banks in the University of Macau provide foreign currency exchange services, which are open during office hours. Therefore, we would recommend the teams to exchange some Macao Patacas once they arrival. Also, Hong Kong Dollars is acceptable for most of the shops and restaurants in Macao, China so you can prepare some Hong Kong Dollars before your arrival. There are some ATMs located near the Dormitory and competition venues. They accept Visa and Master card mainly. There is a shopping mall inside the campus with a food court, a supermarket, a bank, a post office, and a bakery. You will get whatever you need inside. Enjoy!

No-alcohol and no-smoking policy

Participants are not permitted to consume or possess alcoholic beverages, nor are they allowed to smoke cigarettes or use any other tobacco products in the accommodation of the University of Macau. These rules are in place to maintain a safe and responsible environment for all attendees. According to the Macao Law No. 6/2023 — Regime for preventing and controlling the consumption of alcoholic beverages by minors, the people under 18 years old are prohibited from drinking alcoholic beverages. Also, all people, including parents, are prohibited from selling or providing alcoholic beverages to the underage.

Macao travel adaptors

You will need to consider what to pack, to ensure you can use your personal electrical appliances safely whilst abroad. This normally includes the use of a travel adaptor, which is a device that simply allows you to plug any electrical appliance into a foreign electrical socket. It is important to note that it does not convert the voltage or frequency. For Macao, the associated plug type is G, which is the plug that has three rectangular pins in a triangular pattern. Macao operates on a 220V supply voltage and 50Hz.

Medical Service

In case of emergency, there are hospitals and emergency services available 24 hours a day. The medical personnel can speak English, which can help patients who don't speak the local language. There will also be first-aid service, ambulance, and qualified medical personnel in the competition locations. However, participants need to note that they should **bring their necessary medications** with them. The LOC will not be able to provide personal medication or prescriptions.

For the outpatient service, participants can also go to the **Medical Center of the University of Macau in the Room G002 of UM Sports Complex,** with opening hours: Monday to Saturday 09:00 – 13:00 & 14:00 – 18:00. **It will charge MOP\$100 each time.**

Free SIM Card!

A SIM card with 20G data will be provided to all delegation members, for free!! An instruction sheet is attached so you may follow it to activate the data service. However, the card can not used to dial phone calls and sending SMS.



ADDITIONAL INFORMATION



In June, **Macao**, **China** generally has very high temperatures and heavy rainfall. June is a summer month. Throughout the day, temperatures typically settle at around 31°C. But by evening, they drop to around 27°C.

Keep in mind that while these are the average temperatures, there can be days that are even hotter. It's essential to be prepared for such heat.

Macau in June falls under the rainy season with heavy rainfall, averaging around 317 mm for the month. Rain is expected in roughly 20 days. **PLEASE REMEMBER TO BRING YOUR OWN UMBRELLA!!!**
