FINANCES

Balance fee payment

Balance fee payment = Participation fee - Deposit (already paid)

The balance fee payment is to be paid before the start of the event to the LOC account. All bank charges are to be met by the participating delegation.

Participation fee

The participation fee covers full board accommodation for the duration of the event plus competition, cultural program activities, and all local transport from the arrival to the official port of entry to the departure of the delegation.

The participation fee is composed of:

- 1. Rates by night: minimum 60€/night/delegation member
- 2.ISF levy:
 - 100€ per person (ISF members)
 - 150€ per person (non-ISF members)

Bahrain travel adaptors

You will need to consider what to pack, to ensure you can use your personal electrical appliances safely whilst abroad. This normally includes the use of a travel adaptor, which is a device that simply allows you to plug any electrical appliance into a foreign electrical socket. It is important to note that it does not convert the voltage or frequency.

For Bahrain the associated plug type is G, which is the plug that has three rectangular pins in a triangular pattern. Bahrain operates on a 230V supply voltage and 50Hz.





Weather

In October, Bahrain typically experiences warm and pleasant weather as it transitions from the intense summer heat. Average daytime temperatures range between 29°C to 34°C (84°F to 93°F), while nighttime temperatures cool down to around 24°C to 27°C (75°F to 81°F). Humidity levels can still be relatively high, but it's much more comfortable than during the peak summer months.

Rainfall is minimal during October, with mostly sunny or partly cloudy days. It's a good time to visit, as the weather is suitable for outdoor activities, especially in the early mornings and evenings.



Water

Tap water is not recommended for drinking.



Transportation

Taxi and Uber are available and safe to use.

Currency

د.ب. The currency in Bahrain is the Bahraini Dinar, abbreviated as BHD. It is symbolized as or BD. One Bahraini Dinar is subdivided into 1,000 fils. The Bahraini Dinar is one of the highest-valued currencies in the world, and it is often pegged to the US dollar at a rate of approximately 1 BHD = 2.65 USD or 2.40 EUR.

Credit cards

All major credit cards are accepted.



Vaccines

There are no mandatory vaccines specifically required for travel to Bahrain for travelers.

Clothing

When traveling to Bahrain, it's important to dress respectfully, considering the local culture and customs. Here are some guidelines:

- Modest Clothing: While Bahrain is relatively liberal compared to some neighboring countries, modest dress is still appreciated. For women, this typically means clothing that covers the shoulders and knees. Loose-fitting clothes are a good choice.
- Men's Attire: Men can wear shorts and short-sleeved shirts, but it's advisable to avoid overly casual clothing in public spaces. Long pants and shirts are acceptable in more formal settings.
- **Swimwear:** Swimwear is appropriate at beaches and pools, but it should not be worn in public areas outside those environments. Cover up with a sarong or light clothing when leaving the pool or beach.
- Religious Sites: When visiting mosques or other religious sites, women should wear a headscarf and ensure their arms and legs are covered. Men should wear long trousers and shirts with sleeves.
- Climate Considerations: Bahrain can be quite warm, so lightweight, breathable fabrics are advisable, especially during the summer months. Sunglasses, hats, and sunscreen are also recommended for outdoor activities.

By following these guidelines, travelers can ensure they are respectful of local customs while remaining comfortable.

Local Internet Sim cards

In Bahrain, several mobile network providers offer prepaid SIM cards for tourists. Here's a quick overview:

- 1. **Batelco:** One of the largest providers in Bahrain, Batelco offers various prepaid SIM cards with options for data, voice calls, and text messages. Their "Tourist SIM" typically includes a data package that's suitable for short stays.
- 2. **Zain:** Another major provider, Zain offers competitive prepaid SIM cards for visitors. They often have packages with generous data allowances and calling options.
- 3. **Viva:** Viva also provides prepaid options for tourists, including data packages and international calling features.

Where to Buy:

- **Airport:** You can purchase SIM cards upon arrival at Bahrain International Airport from kiosks or stores.
- **Retail Stores:** Major mobile providers have stores in shopping malls and city centers where you can buy SIM cards.
- **Convenience Stores:** Some convenience stores may also sell prepaid SIM cards.

Requirements:

• **Identification:** You'll need to present your passport to purchase a SIM card, as registration is required.

Activation:

Most SIM cards are activated immediately upon purchase, but you may need to follow some instructions for setting up data services.

Using a local SIM card is a convenient way to stay connected during your visit!

eSIM for your mobile device. An eSIM allows you to stay connected without the need for a physical SIM card. It's especially useful for international travel, helping you avoid roaming fees and enjoy more affordable rates.

Please note that not all mobile phones are eSIM-compatible, so make sure to check if your device supports this feature before purchasing.

ISF GYMNASIADE BAHRAIN 2024 ANTI DOPING INFORMATION

ISF adopted the anti-doping rules last year. Therefore, all WADA guidelines regarding testing and education are binding for us.

ISF being a WADA code signatory is promoting clean sport as one of the main values applied during its events. Any participant athlete based on the sport can be subject to testing at the Gymnasiade. Systematic tests can be performed during the competition or on non-competition days. All samples collected shall be analysed at WADA-accredited laboratories.

The course of doping control

The following process will be undertaken as per the WADA guidelines. The control process consists of:

- Selection of an athlete for testing
- Notification to the selected athlete by the doping control officer (DCO) or chaperone
- Athlete to report to the Doping Control Station
- Sample collection
- Providing a sample with the DCO or Chaperone as witness
- Splitting of the sample
- Sealing of the sample
- Measuring specific gravity of the sample
- Completing the Doping Control Form (DCF)
- The secured sample will be sent to the laboratory

Besides the tests that can take place accordingly to the age category and the tradition of relevant sports, ISF in cooperation with WADA is implementing a large educational programme to raise awareness on the danger of doping behaviours. Further details will be included in the ISF Gymnasiade Bahrain 2024 Handbook

In connection with the conduct of doping control, the athlete and support staff have certain rights and obligations. Detailed information in this regard will be included in the ISF Gymnasiade Bahrain 2024 Handbook.







ISF GYMNASIADE BAHRAIN 2024 ISF ACADEMY



The ISF Academy is the educational center of the International School Sport Federation delivering online and onsite capacity-building activities for teachers, school sports representatives, coaches, officials, and students around the world. It aims to recognize and or to upgrade the knowledge and skills of any of these stakeholders involved or planning to be involved in national, continental, or international sports, educational networks, institutions, events, or organisation.

The mission of this body is to design and deliver short-, mid-, and long-term quality education and capacity-building activities for students, physical education teachers, national school sport representatives, coaches and officials around the world. These educational programmes will be held online on the ISF Academy platform prior to the events and particularly during the organisation of ISF events on-site, after the competition hours.

Therefore, before and during this international ISF event, heads of delegation, coaches, referees, international school athletes, and local school students will have the opportunity to take part in various interactive educational activities on different topics.









SAFEGUARDING CHILDREN IN SPORT & ANTIDOPING, MENTAL HEALTH and WELL-BEING WORKSHOPS

As well as various webinars taking place several days before the event to support the Head of Delegation and Coaches in preparing their mission within an ISF event (these online educational & capacity building activities are compulsory to attend for all the following adult stakeholders taking part in ISF events), the ISF's promotion of school sport by the ISF Academy through its international events also involves the transmission of knowledge through workshops on three themes that are dear to us all: Safeguarding Children in Sport and Doping Prevention in Sport and Mental Health and Well-Being.

ISF firmly believes that children must, through these workshops, develop the necessary inner resources to understand, identify, and react to negative behaviors such as racism, gender inequality, violence, and abuse, as well as to gain proper knowledge about doping and appropriately address mental health issues among athletes.

The challenge for ISF is to find the right way to express difficult ideas and present complicated topics to young people so that they understand, but also so that they correctly apprehend this problem and are able to react to it.

Raising awareness and enabling participants to transfer their knowledge to their peers back home are also key elements of ISF. During this event, athletes from all over the world will attend several workshop sessions given by experts in the field, passing on their knowledge and experience through dedicated, constructive, and interactive pedagogy.

Therefore, all athletes participating in ISF events are required to attend the ISF Academy's seminars on safeguarding children, anti-doping, and mental health. These seminars are scheduled to take place on October 25th, 26th, 27th, and 28th, in the afternoon or evening. Specific delegation time slots will be communicated during the event briefing."

The ISF Academy collaborates with various International Federations (IFs) to provide **On-site training for educators such as PE teachers and coaches.** Experts from each IF conduct these training sessions, which are designed to ensure the best performance and physical and emotional safety for athletes. It will take place from **October 25th to 28th, over four days,** in lecture halls and the Fun & Skill Zone.

These educational & capacity building activities are **free** to attend for **International** community PE teacher and Coaches who will participate in the ISF Gymnasiade 2024.
