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ABOUT THE EVENT

The ISF World School Championships have a long-standing history, marking significant milestones in school sports and is adding a new chapter to its story, the **1st edition in Morocco of the WSC Golf Championship**.

This inaugural golf event in Morocco aims to set a new standard for future championships.

Golf in Morocco dates back to 1914. More than a century later, golf in Morocco has grown to brush shoulders with veteran golfing countries such as Spain and Portugal. There are more than 40 world-class golf courses in the country and development of others are underway.

For more than fifty years, Morocco has hosted and organized flagship professional golf tournaments with significant partnerships, including the PGA Tour Champions, the Ladies European Tour, DP World Tour, International Series...

ABOUT WSC

ISF World School Championships (WSC) are events characterized by a balanced program between sport and educational content: the balance between sport and education is to create awareness about the role of sports in putting forward topics such as fair play, healthy lifestyle, respect, and inclusion.

The educational program and the sport format of the event shall always be adapted to the age of participants.

WSC is open to the participation of all students attending a school that provides general education and/or vocational education incorporating segments of general education.

WSC is a team competition, meaning that team results are awarded by trophies, medals, and certificates.

ISF WSC GOLF 2025 TRAVELLING

PORT OF ENTRY

The followings are the official ports of entry:

- Mohammed V International Airport Casablanca: Situated at an hour drive from Rabat.
- Rabat Salé International Airport.

TRAVEL ARRANGEMENTS

Travel to the official ports of entry is to be arranged and financed by each participating delegation.

Delegations are to arrive on July, 14th, 2025 and depart on July 21st, 2025 after breakfast. The organization of an extended stay for the delegation (before or after the event) is a matter of the delegation concerned. It shall not be the responsibility of the Local Organizing Committee.

When the distance between the host city and the capital of a participating delegation on another continent exceeds 5000km, the delegation may extend its stay by arriving one day earlier July 13th, 2025 and/or leaving one day later July 22nd, 2025 at the standard daily fee.

VISA

Each participating delegation is required to check whether a visa is needed to enter Morocco. Please contact the related Embassy or Consulate to consult visa application procedure.

INSURANCE

Each participating delegation is required to provide insurance for each member of its delegation. At a minimum, the insurance is to cover civil liability, material damage, and medical costs.

INDIVIDUAL FORMAT:

• A delegation (country/region) may be represented by a single or two players of distinct junior categories, if they do not have a team.

TEAM FORMAT: DELEGATION (COUNTRY/REGION)

- A team formed by student athletes enrolled in the same school or different schools (select teams) and in the same country which they represent.
- Each delegation can participate with a maximum of 1 team.
- A single team, per delegation, is composed of 4 players
 - U18 [1 Girl + 1 Boy] + U15 [1 Girl + 1 Boy]
 (2 players) + (2 players)

EACH PLAYER MUST:

- Be an amateur golfer in accordance with the Rules of Amateur Status.
- Be licensed from a recognized Golf Federation.
- Have an index < 18.5.

COMPETITION FORMAT:

- Individual Championships: Stroke play / 72 holes / 18 holes per day / Total of the 4 rounds.
- Team Championship: 4 Individuals Stroke play / 72 holes / 18 holes per day / 3 lowest scores count each day.

ISF WSC GOLF 2025 SPORT SPECIFICS

PARTICIPATION

Each delegation is limited to a maximum of 11 members.

The following students may take part in the ISF events:

- The students who are enrolled as full-time students at a school in the country in which they represent.
- The student-athletes must be attending schools that provide general education and/or vocational education incorporating segments of general education.
- Only the students registered on the team list that is handed in at the accreditation are authorized to take part in this competition.

The following are not eligible to participate:

- Attendees of vocational schools, who only attend school as a complement to their vocational training and are not full-time students with a segment of general education.
- Students enrolled at schools that provide sports training without any general education.



SPORT SPECIFICS

COMPOSITION OF DELEGATION

Each delegation shall consists of:

- 1. Head of delegation mandatory
- 2. Student athlete(s) mandatory
- 3. Coaches mandatory
- 4. Other Team Officials optional
- 5. Additional adults optional

Head of the delegation

There is a mandatory amount of one (1) head of the delegation per registering delegation.

The head of the delegation shall be the sole intermediary between the delegation the Local Organising Committee, and the ISF.

He/she may not combine the function with any other official role (i.e., coach, referee, etc.).

Student-athletes

Only the students registered on the team list that was handed in at accreditation are authorized to take part in this championship. Each delegation is entitled to register a maximum of four (4) players: 2 U18 Players (1 Girl + 1 Boy) + 2 U15 Players (1 Girl + 1 Boy).

Teams Officials (Coaches and Other Team Officials)

Coaches

- The presence of coaches is mandatory.
- Each team is entitled to enter maximum of 2 coaches.

Other Team Officials

- The function of the other team officials can be doctors, trainers, physiotherapists, statisticians, team managers, etc.).
- The presence of the other team officials is not mandatory.
- The function of each other team officials must be specified during the registration process.
- Any person not specified during registration or exceeding the limit will not be considered part of the team.
- Each team is entitled to enter up to two (2) other team officials.

Additional adults

- The function of each additional adult must be specified during the registration process (interpreter, security personnel, ministry representative, media, etc.).
- Delegations can register up to 2 additional adults.

N.B

• Each gender within the team should have a chaperone in the absence of coaches, other team officials, or additional adults of the same gender to accompany them.

DISCIPLINARY MANAGEMENT

EVENT DISCIPLINARY COMMISSION

In accordance with the ISF General Competition Rules, the ISF Event Disciplinary Commission shall deal with all incidents and all violations of the ISF Statutes, Sport Policy, ISF Handbook, Rules, and any other ISF document linked to the ISF events and broadly with misbehaviour not directly related to the sport technical regulation during an ISF event.

The Event Disciplinary Commission is composed by ISF Delegate, TC President Golf and the LOC President.

APPEAL JURY

The Appeal Jury shall deal with all protests of a technical sporting nature during the competition.

The Appeal Jury is composed of the President of the Technical Commission, one member of the Local Organising Committee, and the Head Field of Play Officials. The ISF Sport Director can be called upon to join the appeal jury as a neutral participant if a delegation wishes to appeal on the initial decision of the appeal jury.

APPEALS

Please refer to the Appeal section of the ISF Technical Rules and Regulations for the appeal of Golf.

OBLIGATIONS

PARTICIPANTS OBLIGATIONS

- Each participant is required to be present throughout the whole duration of the event.
- Each participant is obliged to take part in all the non-sport activities.
- The absence of any member of a delegation from any part of the entire sport, opening, prize-giving and closing ceremonies and socio-cultural program may result in the individual being excluded from the final results.

ANTI-DOPING

ISF being a WADA code signatory is promoting clean sport as one of the main values applied during its events. Besides the tests than can take place accordingly to the age category and the tradition of relevant sports, ISF in cooperation with WADA is implementing a large educational program to raise awareness on the danger of doping behaviours.

ISF ACADEMY



The ISF Academy is the educational center of the International School Sport Federation delivering online and onsite capacity-building activities for teachers, school sports representatives, coaches, officials, and students around the world. It aims to recognize and or to upgrade the knowledge and skills of any of these stakeholders involved or planning to be involved in national, continental, or international sports, educational networks, institutions, events, or organisation.

The mission of this body is to design and deliver short-, mid-, and long-term quality education and capacity-building activities for students, physical education teachers, national school sport representatives, coaches and officials around the world. These educational programmes will be held online on the ISF Academy platform prior to the events and particularly during the organisation of ISF events on-site, after the competition hours.

Therefore, before and during this international ISF event, heads of delegation, coaches, referees, international school athletes, and local school students will have the opportunity to take part in various interactive educational activities on different topics.





ISF ACADEMY

HEADS OF DELEGATION, COACHES AND REFEREES PROGRAMME

The ISF Academy will organise an online webinar, a few weeks before the event to support the Head of Delegation, Coaches and Referees in preparing their mission within an ISF event. These online educational & capacity building activities are compulsory to attend for all the following adults' stakeholders taking part in ISF events:

- 1) Heads of Delegation (Compulsory)
- 2) Coaches (Compulsory)

The programme will be composed of different modules related to the ISF, the Organising Committee, and several crucial subjects related to Safeguarding Children in Sport, Anti-Doping, and Diplomacy in Sport. Other topics might be added as well.



Any adults having key responsibilities towards, the ISF, the Local Organising Committee, and ultimately school students within an ISF international event shall be taking part in this crucial educational programme which will contribute to supporting these adults in their duty and mission before, during, and after the event.

Important: The head of the delegation, the coaches and the referees will have to participate in the complete training programme to be authorized to receive accreditation for the event.

Note: The Head of Delegations, Coaches will be informed in due time of the dates of the online webinar. The detail programme of this webinar as well.

After each online workshop, participants will receive a link to complete assessments. To validate their certificate of completion, each participant must have a minimum of 50% success rate to all the assessments before receiving the certificate directly by email.

Sign Up

Registration will be done through the official ISF registration system ERAS. Participating delegations will be required to register their members and make Deposit payments. Information to be entered in:

- The exact number of teams and delegation members (athletes (boys/girls), Team officials, FOPO, additional adults
- Name, date of birth date, gender, and passport copy.

Collecting data & information

Delegations are expected to enter the exact detailed information :

- Final detailed information for each participant (photo, dietary requirements, personal bests, jersey number)
- Upload all needed documents online
- Submitting the expected date of arrival and departure, and type of transport
- Rooming list
- Payment overview



MEMBERS ADVANTAGE

We encourage all participants to register through their respective ISF member organization (the national school sport entity responsible for school sports), as the number of teams per country is limited to one. If two teams from the same country register, priority will be given to the team endorsed by the ISF member organization. The final confirmation of participating teams will be announced in Bulletin 2.



ISF WSC GOLF 2025 FINANCIAL CONDITIONS

To participate, each ISF member is required to make two (2) payments:

- 1. Deposit payment
- 2. Balance fee payment

DEPOSIT PAYMENT

Along with the entry and in order to have access to registration phase 2, participating in ISF members will need to pay a deposit of 200€ per participant registered in Phase 1.

Please note that participation in the event is granted only by a deposit payment. Deadline of deposit payment: April 14th 2025

- The sum will be deducted from the total participation cost.
- The deposit must be sent as a single payment for the whole delegation by the organization responsible for school sports (federation, trust, ministry...).
- The deposit is non-refundable in the event of non-participation. Waivers to the payment of the deposit, for whatever reasons, are to be discussed with the ISF office and to be agreed upon before the deposit payment deadlines.

The deposit for the registered participants shall be paid by April 14th 2025.

If the deposit is not paid within the deadline, the registrations will not be considered valid and automatically deleted from ERAS.

Participation fee
