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

VISA

To ensure an efficient visa application process for participation in ISF U15 Gymnasiade 2025, please adhere to the following instructions:

- 1. Visa Application for Adults All adults must apply for a visa online through the official website: **Home Welcome to Serbia**
- 2. Visa Application for Competition Participants For all participants who are confirmed to compete, it is necessary to start the visa application process immediately. If the entire team is ready for visa processing, it is recommended that all applications be submitted together. However, to avoid overloading consular offices, it is advisable to submit applications successively, whenever possible.
- 3. Required Documents Along with the visa application, the following documents must be submitted:
 - a. A clear photograph of the applicant's face
 - b. The first page of the passport
 - c. An invitation letter from the competition organizers
 - d. A supporting document on the competition venue and duration (bulletin)
 - e. Proof of travel health insurance
 - f. A reservation of a return ticket
 - g. Parental consent form for minor travel (attached)

<u>Visas and states travel advisory | Ministry of Foreign Affairs</u>

Visa-Free Entry to the Republic of Serbia The following individuals are eligible to enter Serbia without a visa:

- Individuals holding a valid Schengen visa, a visa from the United Kingdom, a visa from any EU member state, or a visa from the United States
- Holders of foreign travel documents who have a regulated stay in a Schengen zone country, an EU member state, or the United States

4. Contact for Further Information In case of any uncertainties or additional questions, please contact the relevant Serbian consular office in your country or in the country covering your area. Please ensure that you start the visa application process on time, as the procedures are strict and may require additional processing time. We strongly advise against last-minute applications to avoid any potential complications in obtaining visas.

Participation fee



In Zlatibor, you can exchange currency at several licensed exchange offices located in key areas such as Miladina Pećinara Street, Kraljev trg, and near the bus station. Many tourist agencies and travel offices also provide exchange services. Most exchange offices operate daily and offer competitive rates. Additionally, banks and ATMs are widely available for currency exchange and cash withdrawals. It is advisable to check the exchange rate and any potential fees before making a transaction.

COMPETITION MODE

- The competition will be conducted in accordance with the latest IJF SOR and IJF Refereeing Rules. Competition systems according to number of participants:
 - i.6 and more entries: Double repechage
 - ii. If there are two (2) to five (5) athletes Round Robin.
- At least one fight must be won to get a medal.
- If only one (1) athlete passes the weigh-in there will be no competition.
- ISF Sport Director reserves the right to change the competition system in the range 2-5 participants on site.
- The draw will be held as a technical draw during the technical meeting. NO seeding

WEIGH-IN

- Official weigh-in for each weight category is held the evening before the competition day (see program).
- Athletes are not allowed to weigh-in naked. Boys must wear at least underwear and girls at least underwear and a T-shirt. Additional 200g will be allowed for their weight category limits.
- Athletes must present their ISF accreditation card and their passport (National ID Cards showing nationality, picture and date of birth are also accepted).
- Test scales will be available for test weigh-in on all days from 08:00 –20:00 (except during official weigh-in).

JUDOGI

- Blue and white kimono are obligatory.
- Approved Judogi
- The judogi must comply with the size regulations of the IJF. Judogi must comply with the hygiene regulations of the IJF. No red control mark is needed
- Judogi Control
- It will be operated with a Sokuteiki prior to the fight.
- Backnumber
- Back number is desirable but not absolutely necessary.

Important:

- If an athlete does not respect the Judogi rules, the athlete will not be permitted to pass the Judogi Control, and the coach who is responsible for the athlete will be suspended for the rest of the competition day.
- The organiser is not obliged to provide reserve Judogi at Judogi Control, but the athlete is allowed to present himself in another Approved Judogi, complying with the Sokuteiki rule
- In the case of a repeated offence the coach will be suspended for the rest of the competition.

Coach:

- All coaches must fully adhere to the Code of Conduct for Judo Coaches.
- Dress Code Elimination rounds: National track suit with trousers reaching down to shoes

REFEREEING

- Each nation must provide a referee. If a nation is unable to provide a referee, the designated fee is to be paid.
- Each federation may enter 2 referees. The organizing federation may enter as many referees as required for the realization of the tournament but giving priority to their own Continental/International referees first and then their national referees with the highest national license with at least 2 years of experience.
- If enough Continental/International referees are inscribed in, the organizing federation has to limit its number of national referees to 1 per mat.
- The contestants must not shake hands BEFORE the start of the contest.
- When the athletes are leaving the mat they must wear judogi in proper way and are not allowed to take out any part of the judogi or the belt before leaving the field of play.

The rules refers to: ISF rules, IJF Referee rules, IJF Sport and Organisation Rules (SOR), last version

PROTESTS AND APPEALS

- Protests may only be lodged in the case of proven breaches of the sporting rules, technical infringements (e.g. proven incorrect display on the scoreboard until shortly before the end of the bout). No protests may be lodged against the decisions of the Refereeing Panel.
- Exception: The Referee violates the majority rule (e.g. the Referee allows an announced holding technique to run for the full holding time over the objections of the two side referees).
 The protest can only be made while the contestant is on the mat. While the protest is being processed, the table staff shall record the time of the bout up to the time of the protest and the scores already awarded.
- The protest must be submitted to the Tournament Director and the protest fee must be paid. The protest fee will be refunded if the protest is upheld.
- Protest fee: For ISF Judo championships/tournaments the protest fee is €200.
- The protest will be handled and decided by the PROTEST PANEL, consisting of the most senior association official present, the referee in charge and the tournament director

The draw of the team competition will be on Thursday 27 March 2025 13.00 hours Following system will be used:

Cup 1 - The first countries according to the number of groups in Brazil 2023 that finished according to rank at the previous ISF tournament (Serbia 2021) are seeded.

Cup 2 - The countries that participated in Brazil 2023 will be placed in the different groups by drawing lots.

Cup 3 (a and b) - The countries that did not participate in the previous ISF tournament (Brazil 2023) will be placed in the different groups by drawing lots.

If a country registers several teams, the remaining teams go into cup 3a and are initially spread across the groups so that no 2 teams from the same country end up in the same group as far as possible.

The snake principle is used in the drawing of lots.

If there are still changes (absent teams) during the technical meeting, countries will be moved forward according to the ranking of the draw.

For the individual competition, a ranking is established by the technical committee for the creation of groups and the placement in the table. This takes into account:

- the individual results of the player during the team competition,
- the ranking of the players by country specified by the coach,
- international rankings available to the technical committee

SAFEGUARDING CHILDREN IN SPORT & ANTIDOPING & INJURY PREVENTION WORKSHOPS

As well as various webinars taking place several days before the event to support the Head of Delegation and Coaches in preparing their mission within an ISF event (these online educational & capacity building activities are compulsory to attend for all the following adult stakeholders taking part in ISF events), the ISF's promotion of school sport by the ISF Academy through its international events also involves the transmission of knowledge through workshops on three themes that are dear to us all: **Safeguarding Children in Sport, Doping Prevention in Sport** and **Injury Prevention**.

ISF firmly believes that children must, through these workshops, develop the necessary inner resources to understand, identify, and react to negative behaviors such as racism, gender inequality, violence, and abuse, as well as to gain proper knowledge about doping and appropriately address mental health issues among athletes.

The challenge for ISF is to find the right way to express difficult ideas and present complicated topics to young people so that they understand, but also so that they correctly apprehend this problem and are able to react to it.

Raising awareness and enabling participants to transfer their knowledge to their peers back home are also key elements of ISF. During this event, athletes from all over the world will attend several workshop sessions given by experts in the field, passing on their knowledge and experience through dedicated, constructive, and interactive pedagogy.

Therefore, all athletes participating in ISF events are required to attend the ISF Academy's seminars on safeguarding children, anti-doping, and Injury prevention. These seminars are scheduled to take place on April 6th - 11th, in the afternoon after competition. Specific delegation time slots will be communicated during the event briefing.
